Obligations on those under 18 years old

In order to protect children, those who are under the age of 18 must always ask their parent guardian before they:

- email the "Northern Districts' Site", or ask us to email anything to them/another child
- send any information
- enter any competition or game that requires information about themselves/another child or offer a prize:
- apply to join Northern Districts Junior Knights Club
- post any information on any bulletin board or enter any chat room
- offer to agree to buy anything online
