THE ROCK – NORTHERN KNIGHTS \$100,000 SUPER CATCH PROMOTION PROMOTIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PROMOTION SUMMARY

The NORTHERN KNIGHTS \$100,000 SUPER CATCH promotion gives participants the chance to win NZD\$100,000 cash ("Prize"). One person is chosen by The Rock Waikato radio station to stand on a 2m x 2m platform (the Catching Platform") for the first innings of the Northern Knights matches at the Seddon Park Georgie Pie Super Smash Games. If the Match ball is hit over the boundary ("a Six") and is caught on the Catching Platform by the Participant and is deemed a Winning Catch by the Promoters then the Participant will win the Prize. If the Participant is not successful at catching a Six, then at change of innings another Participant is drawn to stand on the platform for the second innings of the Match. There is only one chance to win the Prize each Match, if a Participant makes a Winning Catch they will withdraw from the Catching Platform and no further Participants will be drawn for the remainder of the Match.

PROMOTION MATCHES

1. The Northern Knights \$100,000 SUPER CATCH promotion is available to be won during the Georgie Pie Super Smash Games held at Seddon Park, Hamilton on November 6th, 12th, 20th, 26th and December 5th 2015 ("Match"). Visit www.gotheknights.co.nz for more information.

HOW TO ENTER

- 2. The Promotional Period is from 6.00am on Wednesday 28 October 2015 and closes at 11.00pm on Saturday 5 December 2015. Entry is only valid during the Promotion Period. Entry will be restricted to one per person per Match.
- 3. There are two ways to enter the Promotion, either by texting an entry to The Rock Waikato or by filling in an entry form at a Match:
 - a. Text Entry: To enter by SMS, entrants text the keyword "CRICKET" to 3520 before 5.00pm the day prior to a Match to go into the draw to participate for the first innings of that Match. Entrants must enter individually for each Promotion Match; entries will not be carried over. Entrants may enter using any NZ mobile phone (e.g. 021/022/027/029). Standard network rates of the network operator apply; charges may not be covered by text-inclusive packages, check with your network operator. Please ensure you have permission of the person who pays the mobile bill before entering via SMS: or
 - b. **Entry Form**: Entrants must fill in an official entry form in The Rock Waikato tent at a Match before the end of the 15th over in the first innings of the match to go in the draw to be selected as a Participant on the Catching Platform for the second innings of that Match (only if a Winning Catch has not occurred earlier in the Match).
- 4. A person will be randomly selected from all the Promotion entries; this person will have the potential chance to stand on the Catching Platform and attempt to secure a Winning Catch ("the **Participant**").
- 5. Only one Prize is available per Match, if a Participant secures a Winning Catch in the first innings then the Participant selected for the second innings automatically forfeits their chance to participate.
- 6. Participants will be notified of their chance to participate in the Promotion:
 - a. **Text Entry Participant**: A selected Participant will be notified via phone call from The Rock Waikato crew by 8am the morning of the Match. Reasonable efforts will be made to contact Participant using the information provided at the time of entry. The Promoter reserves the right to redraw or reallocate any Participant if they cannot be contacted within a reasonable period, as determined by the Promoter at its sole discretion or if the Participant cannot attend the Match.
 - b. **Entry Form Participant**: A selected Participant will be drawn randomly and announced over the PA Systems at the change of innings at the Match where they will have 5 minutes to head to the SUPER CATCH ZONE where the Catching Platform is

located. If the Participant does not present themselves within this time then a new Participant will be drawn and they will have 5 minutes to present themselves and so on until a Participant has made their way to the Catching Platform.

- 7. To participate in and/or claim a Prize in the Promotion, you must be a New Zealand resident and 18 years of age or older.
- 8. The Georgie Pie Super Smash schedule and individual Match conditions, durations, dates and venues may be subject to change from time to time. Any changes made to the schedule or to a Match are outside of the Promoter's control. Participants will be solely responsible for ensuring that they keep up to date with any changes. The Promoter will not be liable to any person for anything as a result of any such changes. If the game is cancelled due to weather or other event, the Prize will not be transferred to another match.
- 9. The Participant is responsible for ensuring their availability for the Match and making their way to the Catching Platform.

HOW TO WIN:

- 10. The winner will catch cleanly a ball hit for Six while standing on the Catching Platform. The catch must meet the Winning Catch criteria as detailed in clause 11 below.
- 11. **Winning Catch**: The following criteria applies to a Winning Catch:
 - a. a Winning Catch must be a clean catch of a 'six' hit during a Match;
 - b. the Participant must be wearing the provided ROCKFM Tee at the time of making the catch; and
 - c. the Winning catch must be taken while standing on the Catching Platform. A clean catch is one where the ball does not make contact with anything after leaving the bat until caught by the Participant after being struck out of the field of play. The catch can be made either one or two handed and any part of the Participants body can be used to assist taking the clean catch. The ball though cannot touch any other object except the Participants body. The participant must have at least one foot on the platform for the catch to be eligible and must be still on the platform after the conclusion of the catch. The Participant can jump to catch the ball but must land on the Catching Platform to be eligible to win the Prize. The Participant can use handrails or furniture on the Catching Platform for balance but cannot use the Catching Platform for elevation or jumping off. The prize will not be awarded unless or until verification of the Winning Catch is made by the Promoter and the Promoter is satisfied that the criteria for a Winning Catch and these Promotion Terms and Conditions have been met. In verifying the Winning Catch, the Promoter will review the coverage of the catch made on a stadium video, security or TV camera. The Promoter's decision is final. Any alleged Winning Catch not captured on a camera and therefore not able to be reviewed by the Promoter will be deemed a non-eligible catch.

PRIZES

12. The Access Prize:

- a. a Text Entry Participant (who entered via SMS text to The Rock Waikato) and was selected will receive one ticket to the Match that they are a Participant for and access to the SUPER CATCH ZONE for them and up to 9 of their friends. The Participants are responsible for all travel costs associated with getting to and from the Match (Seddon Park), and any other costs associated with the Promotion; and
- a Entry Form Participant will receive access to the SUPER CATCH ZONE for them and up to 9 of their friends for the second innings of the Match (unless a Winning Catch has already occurred in the Match and so their chance to participate is forfeited).
- 13. **The Prize**: there is one NZD\$100,000 prize available per Match payable by Northern Districts Cricket Association.
- 14. A Participant who successfully completes a Winning Catch in accordance with the Promotion's terms and conditions will be entitled to receive the Prize ("the **Winner**"). No person under 18 years of age is eligible to receive a Prize. The Prize will be paid by means of direct credit into

the Winner's nominated bank account on a date to be advised by the Promoter. It is the Winner's responsibility to ensure that the correct name, address and bank account details are provided to the Promoters. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any Prize deposited into the wrong or incorrect bank account. The Promoter reserves the right to conduct a security verification check at their absolute discretion. A Winner may be required to sign a declaration confirming their eligibility to accept the Prize. The Promoter reserves the right to request proof of identity from any winner. Proof of identity includes but is not limited to a valid driver's licence and/or passport.

OTHER

- 15. Personal information provided at the time of entry is presumed to be true and, in the case of text or email notification active, through to and beyond the date of the Promotion's completion.
- 16. Where the Promotion involves texting, the following apply:
 - a. standard sms text charges will apply, and will depend on the entrant's particular plan or agreement with their phone service provider;
 - b. any form of automated text message is invalid;
 - c. the telephone number from which the entry was made will be stored in a database. The entrant has a two-business-day period from the time of entry to request removal from the database.
 - d. Participants are responsible for all connection costs charged by their network operator. If you do not pay the bill please get permission from the person who does;
 - e. if no request is made it is deemed acceptance that the information can be used for future promotion and marketing purposes; and
 - f. The Promoters takes no responsibility for text costs incurred after the Promotion Period has ended.
- 17. In the event of a dispute the Promoter's decision is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 18. By participating in the Promotion, participants consent to the use of their name, video footage and photograph for any promotional purposes carried out by the Promoters.
- 19. Promotion winners may be required to take part in any publicity accompanying or resulting from the Promotion. Unless otherwise specified by the Promoter, no additional compensation will be provided by the Promoters for such participation.
- 20. The Promoters will endeavour to ensure that all relevant means of entry into the Promotion are available at all times during the Promotional Period, but cannot guarantee availability and is not liable for any disruptions or system failure.
- 21. The Promoters reserves the right to suspend or cease any means of entry into the Promotion at its sole discretion.
- 22. The Promoters reserves the right to change these terms and conditions, without prior notice and at its discretion or to extend, postpone or discontinue the Promotion at any time.
- 23. The Promoters may refuse to award a prize to any participant if, in the Promoter's sole opinion, that participant has violated these Terms and Conditions or has gained an unfair advantage in participating in the Promotion.
- 24. The Prizes are as stipulated and are non-transferable. No other family members, friends, office associates or any other person will be able to participate on the Participants behalf, or collect the Prize on the Winners behalf.
- 25. Participants shall indemnify the Promoters for any loss it sustains as a result of a participants act or omission causing loss or injury to another person or entity.
- 26. These Terms and Conditions are subject to all applicable laws, codes and regulations of New Zealand.
- 27. The Promoters adhere to all applicable privacy laws and regulations. Participants in the Promotion agree that the Promoter (and its agents and contractors) may collect and retain their personal information in order to conduct the Promotion and for future promotions carried out by the Promoter and its associated companies. Participants have the right to request access to their personal information held by or on behalf of the Promoters, and to update or remove any such information. All such requests should be directed to the Promoters in writing at the address set out above.

- 28. Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, the Promoters will not be liable for any damage whatsoever incurred by any participant (including but not limited to any indirect or consequential loss). All prizes are taken entirely at the prize winner's own risk. Prize winners indemnify the Promoters against any liability for accident or loss of life, personal injury, property damage or other loss, cost or expense arising in connection with the Promotion or any prize. The Winner is responsible for all tax or other costs that may be associated with the Prize.
- 29. Where the prizes are to be supplied by an entity outside MediaWorks control and that entity fails, for whatever reason, to supply the prize, MediaWorks has no responsibility for the provision of the prize and is not obliged to provide an alternative prize or to take legal action to require the prize supplier to provide the prize.

ACCEPTANCE

- 30. Participation in the Promotion is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- 31. If the Winner does not accept these Terms and Conditions the Prize will be forfeited.

DEFINITIONS

"Disqualified Participants" means:

- (a) all MediaWorks and Northern Districts Cricket employees and their boards, all employees of participating sponsors or promoters and/or advertising agencies and their Immediate Families;
- (b) all people under the age of 18 years where the prize incorporates air travel or any other element which would be illegal to supply to a person under the age of 18 years;
- (c) non New Zealand residents.

"MediaWorks"

means all companies in the MediaWorks Group including but not limited to MediaWorks TV Limited, MediaWorks Radio Limited and all brands and operating companies controlled by or associated with those entities;

"Promoter"

is Northern Districts Cricket Association of Seddon Park, Hamilton, New Zealand and MediaWorks;

"Immediate Families"

include spouses, Grandparents, Parents, Children, and Grandchildren whether by marriage, past marriages, remarriage, adoption, cohabitation or other family extension.
